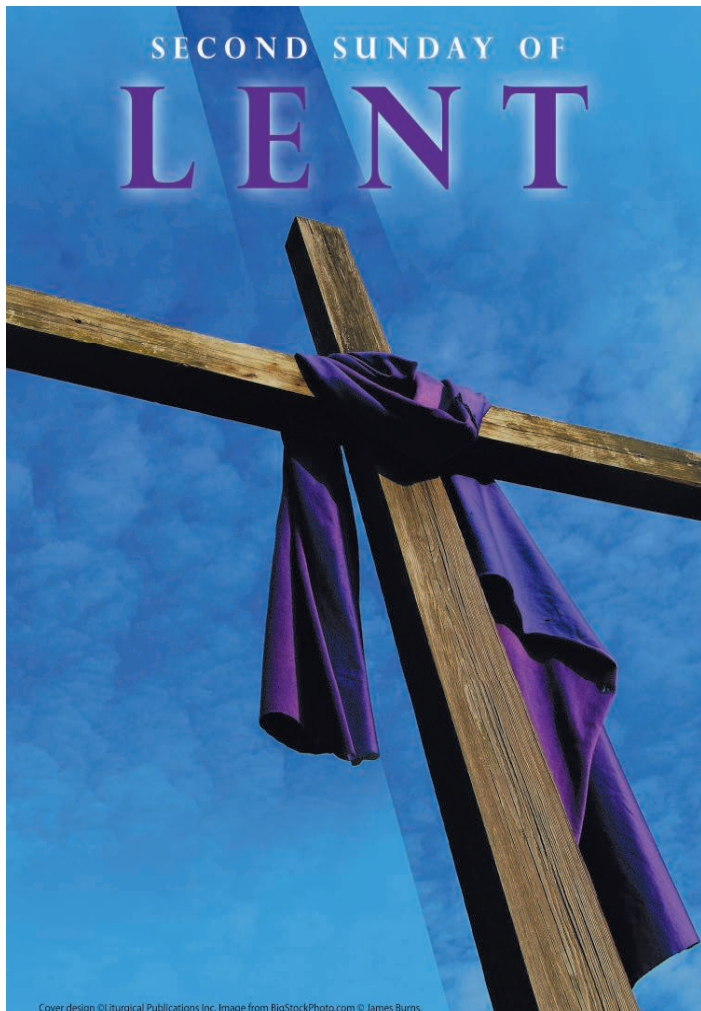

After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected *sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult* to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Jenifer Valenti, at 816.812.2500 or JeniferValenti@att.net, if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.

As part of the church's unified focus on the spiritual and corporal works of mercy, the Green Team encourages you to consider how the concept of "mercy" relates to God's creation. During Lent, please visit the bulletin board in the vestibule to see ways in which the corporal works of mercy play out in caring for the environment. If you know someone that may benefit from a "green tip," feel free to share the following with someone in the spirit of loving the Earth:

Have you ever thought about the amount of stuff you throw in your trash can? The founders of Terracycle have. Terracycle is an organization that has found ways to recycle/upcycle common items that previously found their ways into landfills. Some of these items include writing utensils, toothpaste tubes, juice pouches, and even makeup containers. You can either team up with friends or co-workers to earn money for a charity of choice, or go it solo and just keep your personal items out of a landfill. Learn how you can get involved in one of their brigades and start recycling some of these items at terracycle.com

Hazardous waste should NEVER be thrown in with your regular trash. These items include but are not limited to old automotive products, batteries, fluorescent lights, household cleaners, old thermostats, paint products, and other chemicals. Be sure to take these products to a household hazardous waste drop-off location. The closest one to GA is at 4707 Deramus Ave in KC, MO. They accept materials Thursday-Sat and it is free of charge to KC, MO residents (ID and proof of residency required).

Lenten "Shoebox" Project: This annual Lenten project collects essentials for Shelters caring for women & children. Items included are shampoo, lotion, soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, combs, deodorant, socks, etc. Please put the items in large recloseable bags, rather than shoeboxes.
