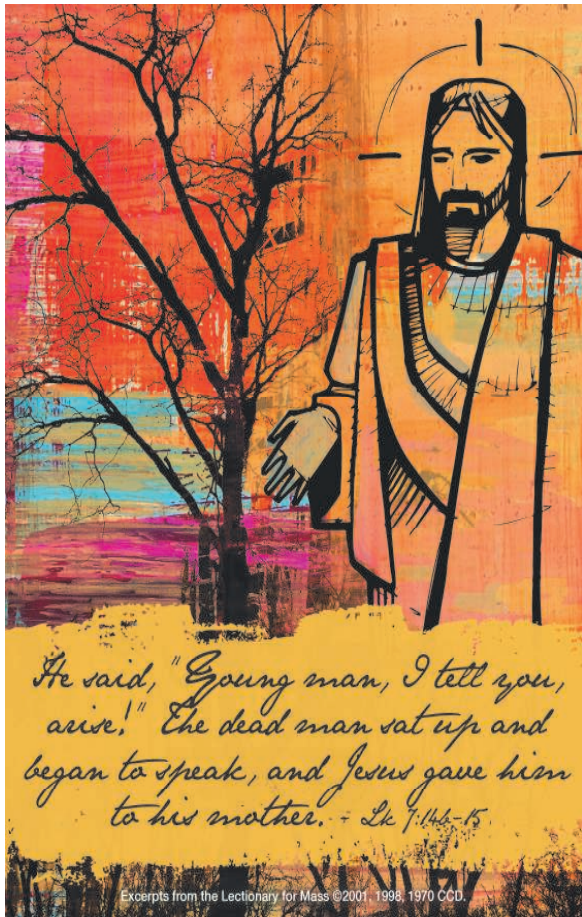

The Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph is committed to combatting sexual abuse in the Church. If you are a victim of sexual abuse, or if you observe or suspect sexual abuse:
1. Call the Missouri Child Abuse Hotline at 1.800.392.3738 (if the victim is currently under the age of 18), and
2. Contact your local law enforcement agency or call 911, and
3. After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Jenifer Valenti, at 816.812.2500 or JeniferValenti@att.net, if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.

Guardian Angels own, Hyunki Yoon has been invited to be a guest artist and pianist in Austria (Vienna), Czech Republic (Brno), and Spain (Malaga) from June 17 to June 26. He will present a collection of Korean Folk Music as a solo piano performer and collaborate as the pianist for Austrian singers and a Korean traditional music ensemble.

In his Europe performance tour, he will present "The Meeting Between Eastern and Western Music: Korean Folk and Traditional Music" in Korea Kulturhaus Österreich (Koran Culture Center in Vienna) and Bezirksmuseum Floridsdorf (Vienna Museum Concert Hall) on June 17 and 19. He will also be a guest pianist at Kefestast (Catholic Music Festival) in Brno, Czech Republic on June 24 and 25. He will conclude his European tour in the Danish Church in las Lagunas, Malaga, Spain on June 26. **Hyunki will perform at our Festival this Sunday in preparation for the Tour.**



Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or RCIA

One of the faith journeys that takes place at most parishes is the process of RCIA. This is the way a person who is interested in either becoming Catholic or is thinking about our faith engages with other adults in learning, reflecting, praying and sharing about what it means to be part of the Catholic Church. 10,000 Acts of Mercy Challenge

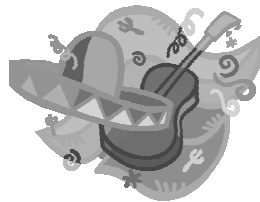
